### ✓ TUITION

- Full Year \$12,500
- One School Term \$5,000

(This fee is payable in advance and includes uniform.  
It does not include homestay fee, insurance,  
examination fees or airport pick-up costs)

✓ **OUTDOOR EDUCATION** \$500

✓ **STATIONERY** \$150

✓ **ACTIVITY/INCIDENTAL COSTS** \$400

✓ **NZQA EXAMINATION FEES (Yr 11 to 13)** \$400

✓ **HEALTH & TRAVEL INSURANCE (annual)** \$600

### ✓ HOMESTAY

Cost per week: \$200  
Placement Fee: \$150

The total cost for the duration of planned study  
must be paid in advance.

The Refund Policy for Kaiapoi High School is based on Section 4B(7)  
of the Education Amendment Act (N.4) 1991.

- In order to be eligible for any refund the parents must apply in writing to the School.
- If notice of cancellation is received in writing two weeks before the start of the course, full tuition fees will be refunded, less any agency fees. The School reserves the right to deduct an administration cost of \$250.
- If the parents wish to cancel the student's further study after the course has started, the following will be deducted: (a) administration costs, (b) agent's commission, (c) at least one term's fees.
- Except in exceptional circumstances (as determined by the School), no refund will be payable to parents who withdraw the student in the second half of the course. In the case of a full-time student, this would be at the commencement of Term 3.

- Kaiapoi High School has arranged Fees Protection Insurance in compliance with the Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students.
- Kaiapoi High School has agreed to observe and be bound by the Code of Practice for the Pastoral Care of International Students published by the Ministry of Education.
